1	NO	\$17B Bond Debt for Rental Housing Despite the deceptive title, this bond only backs \$1.25B in Veteran Home Loans (the rest is debt to build rentals)
2	NO	Guts the State Budget Cap Creates a Slush Fund for Politicians; ignores mandatory rebate thresholds
3	NO	Makes (2) Tax Hikes Permanent Affects income earners over \$370K
4	NO	Taxpayer-Funded Campaigns Pay for candidates, like it or not!

C	NO	\$99M School Bond/Tax for Los Banos Unified School District Could cost \$177M on top of their \$164M in current bond debt
T	NO	Changes Livingston City Clerk to an Appointed Position Voters lose the ability to elect and recall this vital position
U	NO	Changes Livingston Treasurer to an Appointed Position Voters lose the ability to elect & recall this vital position
V	NO	Changes Los Banos Treasurer to an Appointed Position Voters lose the ability to elect & recall this vital position
W	NO	\$33.8M School Bond/Tax for Merced Union High School District Could cost \$112.5M on top of their current bond debt of \$283M
X	NO	\$59.1M School Bond/Tax for Merced Union High School District Could cost \$196.6M on top of their current bond debt of \$283M
Z	NO	\$129M School Bond/Tax for Merced Union High School District Could cost \$429.6M on top of their current bond debt of \$283M
